
















The Story So Far...

'Feel A Little Needy'

After the sudden death of his father Mark decided to take some time out to travel and during his time in Beijing and Johannesburg witnessed extremes of poverty. Having given all his money away and working his way back to the UK he settled back into the London studio scene. During this period, he wrote the lyric to 'Feel A Little Needy' referencing how he watched the wealthy walking past beggars on a footbridge in Beijing and the oppressed ignored by the world in the townships of Soweto. This tender but kicking 90's influenced pop rock song had wide acclaim from fellow musicians on the social media musician site drooble.

'Texas Doctor'

As a child, having been forced into and bullied by both senior students and teachers at school. And therefore Marks' mistrust of any manipulative authority shines in his lyrics. His post punk influence can be heard in the bouncing, raucous, punk blues rock 'Texas Doctor' which was inspired by the shenanigans of Donald Trump. Mark's lyric epitomises the colonial and racist attitudes during the days of the American Wild West that still stand today. The Stones influenced chord progressions, driving rhythm, aggressive lyric and enormous guitar riffs will make this an all-time classic of the future. 'Oh Yeah!'

'Sugar Child'

While living in New York City Mark frequented the club scene in and around Greenwich Village and in particular the live venue Webster Hall close to the Ukrainian Village. During an event Mark was introduced to a fellow musician playing at Carnegie Hall and fell for this lovely young lady who spent her time teasing him with her dance. They fell for each other and spent several sexy weeks together in New York. Sadly, this friendship ended when she confessed, she was gay and had only experimented with Mark for her own sexual gratification. Mark had the idea for 'Sugar Child' from this experience and constructed the lyric around this story.
